About The Clairvoyant Program

The Clairvoyant Program at the San Jose Psychic Institute is a year-long immersive experience for the acquisition of psychic tools and skills. The classes and activities offered are designed to provide participants the opportunity to become proficient with the following tools and techniques:

- Grounding
- Running Energy
- Being in the Center of Your Head (being present, or mindfulness)
- Meditation
- De-energizing mental images (blowing pictures)
- Maintaining separation from others' energies (separation rose)
- Clearing other energies from one's space
- Being in neutral
- Spiritual Communication: Spirit to Spirit "Hello"
- Seeing Energy, i.e. Reading Roses, Chakras, and Auras
- ...and a great deal more.

The milestones to completion of the program are:

- Completion of the beginning six-week classes at SJPI including Beginning 6-Week Classes: Tap Into Your True Self I & II, Healing I & II, and Mens' Class or Womens' Intuition as appropriate. (Tap Into Your True Self I is a prerequisite to beginning the Clairvoyant Program classes and activities. The other classes *may* be taken concurrently with participation in the Clairvoyant Program. We encourage you to complete most or all of the six-week classes before beginning the Clairvoyant Program in order to keep your schedule manageable.)
- Participation in 1 or more 2 two-hour aura readings and the pre required for these readings per week.
- Participation in numerous shorter readings called "Energy Checks" at least once-a-month
- 48 Clairvoyant class meetings or more.
- work on a project of your choice that benefits our community.

To complete the program in a year, your schedule for each week would include

One or more 2-hour aura readings (or more, there is no limit) on Tuesdays at 6:30 - 10:00

One Clairvoyant class meeting usually on Thursday Evenings at 6:30 - 9:30 pm

*Create your community project. This is vital in order to sustain a thriving spiritual community.

Participate In two “Erasure Lectures” These happen every 6 months and are a vital part of the information taught in the Clairvoyant Program. These Lectures take place on a Thursday CV Class and the following Friday evening and all day Saturday.

Once a month Energy Check Sessions that happen on the first Saturday of the month 1:00 - 4:00 PM.

You will have a one week break per quarter.

All Times and Days of your readings, classes, and other events may be subject to change

The program is designed to be transformative: you will acquire new skills, become comfortable doing things that some consider impossible, confront and surmount seemingly impenetrable personal obstacles, break inner constraints that you hadn't even been aware of. It's a powerful growth experience, sometimes intense. We do our best to keep it light: expect lots of bad jokes, laughter at any time, and offers of energy checks or a healing when you're having a growth period.

Clairvoyant Program Components:

A two-hour aura reading is an event for the person receiving the reading, but more like 3½ hours for the readers. You are asked to arrive *on time* a full hour before the reading begins to run your energy, participate in a group meditation, and perhaps give healings to beginning students or even do short energy checks (a form of reading). After the reading is over the staff person running the reading(s) conducts a “clean out” of about 1/2 hour.

Clairvoyant class meetings are held every Thursday. These evening classes begin at 6:30. You will run your energy for half an hour and participate in an opening meditation. Your Clairvoyant Class is 6:30 - 9:30 PM

Monthly Energy Checks are held on the first Saturday of each month 1:00 - 4:00 PM. Upon arrival, run your energy “find your space” for half an hour. You will have the opportunity to give energy checks to 6-Week Students and receive energy checks from staff and your peers.

Community Benefit Project is another way to contribute to CCSG. Many students and graduates make regular donations of money to help pay our rent, utilities, etc. These are our only source of funds. But far more is necessary to keep our community going. Donations of time and talent of all kinds, from cleaning to Webmaster work, are essential to keeping the church and institute going. As a clairvoyant student, the time you spend lending your skills to the community is also an opportunity to integrate your psychic tools into familiar activities, to make grounding, running energy, and using a rose a part of

your everyday routine. Here are some examples of ways you can contribute time and talent to the community:

- Making posters
- Doing layout of flyers, etc
- Writing announcements, text for flyers and website, etc
- Editing text written by others
- Layout and distribution of our electronic (email) newsletter
- Data entry and database management
- Governmental relations
- Website management (webmaster)
- Anything you're good at, or that you'd like to practice, and that you think would help CCSG & SJPI is a good possibility. This is only a partial list.

Additional Program Requirements :

- Be free of any mind altering drugs or alcohol during any CCSG activity
- Be on time to all activities
- Meditate a half hour before each scheduled event
- Be nice to each other, the teacher, fellow classmates, readees and to yourself
- Be in Kindergarten: Play, learn, grow
- Have amusement: Be able to laugh at oneself!
- Payment of program contributions
